The Bradford Curve is a thriller with franchise potential in the vein of the Bourne series.

The world's most trusted trend forecaster, Charles Bradford, is called on by the current president to help guide the country and the world in an economic crisis. During the course of his research, he discovers a much greater threat coming.

Earl King, a dark horse candidate from a mysterious third party upsets conventional wisdom by winning the presidency of the United States. Bradford's attempts to warn of looming catastrophe are shut down by the new president who tries to lure Bradford into his inner circle. Bradford rejects the new president's offers.

Then the threats begin.
